**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1000.7 (REQUIRED
FENCING, SCREENING, AND LANDSCAPING) OF THE
ALBERTVILLE ZONING ORDINANCE (APPENDIX A) OF THE
2005 ALBERTVILLE MUNICIPAL CITY CODE RELATING
TO PROHIBITED TREES WITHIN THE CITY**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBERTVILLE, MINNESOTA ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Section 1000.7.F. (Types of Plantings) is hereby amended with the following:

1000.7: REQUIRED FENCING, SCREENING, AND LANDSCAPING:
