

## Information on potential spring flooding in Albertville

The City of Albertville continues to monitor rising water levels, it is important that residents, property owners, and other stakeholders are able to keep up with the latest information regarding this challenge. **IF YOUR SUMP PUMP** is connected to the sanitary system, route it outdoors immediately and make sure all sewer clean outs in the yard are capped.

**March 15, 2010** With the rain last week, much of the snow had melted. Storm water ponds are getting full, but continue to have additional capacity. The City is monitoring storm water systems throughout the community. The Fieldstone Elementary School (Albert Villas Pond) has approximately ten feet of freeboard. As on today, the flows into the pond have slowed substantially. A significant rain event could cause flooding problems and residents are encouraged to monitor this site for more information.
