1. heighten crime and drug prevention;
2. generate support for and participation in local anti-crime programs;
3. strengthen neighborhood spirit and police-community partnerships; and send a message to criminals letting them know that neighborhoods are organized and fighting back.

We encourage you to plan an outside event in your neighborhood, such as a potluck barbeque or picnic. For safety reasons NO street may be blocked off to through traffic.
